


Secular tailwinds driving digital transformation

- Today, constituents expect public services to use emerging technologies to reduce costs, increase efficiency and improve service quality
- Technologies originally developed for international conflict and military applications have increasingly been adopted domestically and at the local government level
- · US-based companies have seen a significant deployment of capital
 - 63% of investors are US-based
- Increase confidence in new technologies, such as blockchain and AI, has led to the government automating processes and using virtual storage for documentation
- Large industry players are rapidly being recapitalized by private equity firms, leading to more aggressive M&A activity post recapitalization
- The majority of acquisitions within the Public Safety / First Responder Technology & Services sector have been made by strategic buyers, which has supported higher valuations



Annual Public Safety / First Responder Technology & Services Deals Revenue Multiples¹




Public Safety / First Responder Technology & Services Deals by Year¹







EV / LTM Revenue




EV / NTM Revenue










LTM Gross Margin




LTM EBITDA Margin


